

Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies to help us to provide a positive user experience and to provide us with information about usage of the website to allow us to make improvements to the site. Cookies are small text files that are stored on the hard drive of the device you use to access our website. We may use both "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies on the website.

We will use the session cookies (also known as temporary cookies) to track your activities whilst you navigate the website. Session cookies will be deleted when you close your browser.

We will use the permanent cookies (also known as persistent cookies) to enable our website to recognise you when you visit. Permanent cookies will remain stored on your computer after you close your web browser until they are either deleted or they reach a specified expiry date.

Third parties (for example advertising networks and providers of web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies over which we have no control. These are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of this website. Google generates statistical information about website usage through the use of cookies. The information generated relating to our website can be used to create reports about the use of the website.
